



Summer 2008 in Tampere, Finland Civil Engineering (open for all engineering disciplines)

Location: Houghton, Chicago, & Tampere, Finland

Dates: May 12 to June 12, 2008 (The program will start in Houghton from Mon., May 12 – Mon., May 19, then the group will travel to Green Bay and Chicago for Tue., May 20 - Thurs., May 22, and then on to Tampere, Finland from Fri, May 23 – Thurs., June 12)

Language: English

Housing: Lodging will be provided for Chicago and Tampere. Housing in Houghton for students outside Michigan Tech arranged for a separate fee.

Cost: Program Fee 2008 = \$2,200-2,400 depending on number of students (Includes tuition & fees for 6 credits, lodging in Chicago & Tampere, and field trips)
Deposit = \$500 non-refundable deposit is due by January 31, 2008 (this will count toward Program Fee)
Meals and personal expenses= \$600 * (in Chicago & Tampere)
Airfare = \$900-1,000 * (Chicago-Tampere/Helsinki-Chicago)
